Mission Statement of Foundation:

- Monitor programs for adherence to the mission, as well as progress toward stated goals and objectives
- Oversee personnel (staff and volunteers)
- Manage funds

Structure:

The Board of Trustees shall consist of the members of the TMS Executive Committee. The TMS President will serve as the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees.

Term of Office:

Membership on the Board of Trustees will be concurrent with the term as members of the TMS Executive Committee

Meeting Schedules:
