





SCOPE

Whether in research or industry, OMVPE is now a leading epitaxial-materials technology. The Ninth OMVPE Workshop follows the tradition begun at Cornell in 1983, and provides a forum for the exchange of recent scientific and technical knowledge. Scientists from industry, academia and government labs are invited to participate by presenting OMVPE-related papers. Technical sessions will cover the spectrum from fundamental to applied OMVPE topics. Exchange is an important feature of the workshop and the site and format have been chosen to promote informal interaction and communication.

TECHNICAL SESSIONS

The Ninth Biennial Workshop on Organometallic Vapor Phase Epitaxy Technical Program will commence at 8:30 AM on Monday, May 24, 1999. All sessions will be held at the Sawgrass Marriott. Session and paper titles are included in this mailer.

PUBLICATION OF WORKSHOP PAPERS

Papers accepted for the Ninth Biennial Workshop on OMVPE will be reviewed for inclusion in a special issue of the *Journal of Electronic Materials (JEM)*.

Papers for the special issue must not have been published previously and are not currently under consideration elsewhere. The primary purpose of *JEM* is to provide an archival record of new and original technical work that advances the science and technology of electronic materials.

Deadline for receipt of papers for possible inclusion in the October 1999 issue of the *Journal of Electronic Materials* is May 10, 1999. Two copies of your manuscript (accompanied by a diskette containing your paper) must be provided along with the required TMS Transfer of Copyright form. Click on Author Guidelines within the Additional Features area on the home page, followed by clicking on the *Journal of Electronic Materials* (author guidelines) link, or use the following address: http://www.tms.org/ pubs/journals/JEM/authorguide.html.

Note that each paper must be accompanied by:

- The corresponding author's name and address (building name or street name and number if possible).
- An abstract and key words line.
- A diskette containing the algove-not god items.

The TMS transfer of copyright form signed by the appropriate person for each paper (see TMS website at address noted above). Photo, fax and e-mail copies of this form are acceptable.

Please note that the *Journal of Electronic Materials*, like many other scientific and technical journals, depends on author page charges for a significant part of its support. Therefore, a charge of \$110 per printed page is levied for all papers published. One hundred reprints will be supplied without additional charge for every paper on which the payment of these charges is authorized.

CONFERENCE TOUR (Ticketed Event)


On Tuesday afternoon we have organized a tour of historic St. Augustine. Transport from the Sawgrass Marriott to St. Augustine will be provided, along with a tram tour of the area, followed by the opportunity to wander through the town at your leisure before returning to Sawgrass.

- St. Augustine is the nation's oldest city and is a history lover's paradise. Its living history includes archeological remains dating from the 16th century, and a 17th century Fortress that has proven to be impregnable. Florida was first discovered in 1513 by Ponce de Leon, and was founded in 1565 by Spanish Admiral Pedro Menendez as a colony. St. Augustine was established as a strategic sea and land base to block foreign advances against the Spanish Empire. (St. Augustine was also the birthplace of Christianity in this country.) Cost is \$30.00 per session.
- Famous attractions include the Bridge of the Lions, Fountain of Youth, Ripley's Believe It or Not Museum, Zorayda Castle (a replica of Spain's Alhambre Castle), the Oldest House (depicting 400 years of history), the Castillo de San Marcos (this old fort has never been taken by force), the enchanting St. George Street (in the heart of the restoration area), and the Lightner Museum (famous for antique furnishings, costumes, mechanical musical instruments and other artifacts of 19th century daily life).




