

EXHIBITOR QUICK-REFERENCE GUIDE

Inbound Shipment Instructions

Exhibitors may ship exhibit materials in boxes or on pallets. All freight must be labeled in the following manner to ensure proper delivery:

Multiple boxes must be numbered (i.e., Box 1 of 4 Boxes), and the return address must include a contact name and phone number.

Shipments will not be accepted earlier than June 1, 2010.

Expecting a last-minute shipment? McKenna Hall receives UPS and FedEx deliveries throughout the day.

Outbound Shipment Instructions

The University does not have a preferred carrier for outbound shipments, so exhibitors may feel free to use a carrier of their choice. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to pack up and arrange pick up and payment for returning materials following the conference. Storage space is limited, so please have your materials picked up as promptly as possible.

Business Services

The University maintains a business center in McKenna Hall, and additional sundry items can be purchased at the University bookstore.

Wireless Internet Access

Complimentary internet access will be available in McKenna Hall during the exhibition. Log-in information will be available on-site.

Housing Information

Make your reservations directly with the hotel and identify yourself as an EMC attendee to receive the special conference rate. Friday and Saturday night stays are available if requested at the time your reservation is made, however, special rates may not apply.
