## Vittorio de Nora Prize for Environmental Improvements in Metallurgical Industries

### About the Vittorio de Nora Prize for Environmental Improvements in Metallurgical Industries

This prize recognizes outstanding materials science research and development contributions to the reduction of environmental impacts, and particularly greenhouse gas emissions, as applied in global metallurgical industries, especially focused on extractive processing. This prize commemorates Vittorio de Nora, a pioneer in the materials processing field and one of the great Italian technologists of the 20th century.

#### The Award

Five annual awards will be made beginning in the year 2010. The prize consists of a cash award of \$20,000 and a certificate. The award in 2012 will be \$25,000 as that is the centennial anniversary of the birth of Vittorio de Nora.

#### Award Winner Responsibilities

The awardee is required to make a presentation at the TMS Annual Meeting & Exhibition the year that the award is received. The recipient must submit a title and abstract of the presentation upon agreeing to accept the award. (If necessary, funds are available to defray travel costs to the meeting.)

#### Selection Process

- A recommendation will be made by a selection committee to the TMS Board of Directors for final approval. The selection committee will be comprised of five members appointed by the TMS Vice President and approved by the TMS Board of Directors.
- The recipient of the prize will be notified by August 31 and will receive the prize the following year.
- Unsuccessful candidates may update their applications and resubmit for consideration for the following year's prize.

#### Application Requirements

1. Applicants must submit an appropriate but concise selection of reports, papers, patent applications, and other documentation relating to the significance of the technical contribution, including information that demonstrates technical impact based on cost analyses, scale-up information or plant trials. Technologies with global impact are especially relevant.
2. A statement must be included from senior management at the applicant's place of employment indicating the applicant is responsible for the research and development contribution. (All information provided in connection with the application will be treated in confidence by the reviewing committee.)
3. Priority will be given to individual applicants not older than 40 years of age at the time the application is submitted. Joint applications will be considered in appropriate circumstances.
