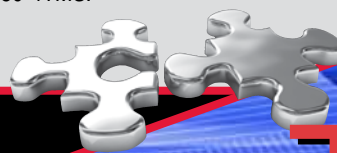
Included among its professional and student members are metallurgical and materials engineers, scientists, researchers, educators and administrators from more than 90 countries on six continents.
