Society Awards Timeline (11-month cycle)

April 1
Deadline for Nominations

June-August
Society-level award selections are made by award subcommittees, followed by review and approval by the Honors and Professional Recognition Committee.

October
TMS Board of Directors reviews and approves society-level award recipients as recommended by the Honors and Professional Recognition Committee.

November
Award recipients and principal nominators are notified of their selection.

February-March
Awards are presented during the TMS Annual Meeting.

Division Awards Timeline (11-month cycle)

April 1
Deadline for Award Nominations

May-August
Appointed division award subcommittees review and make selections.

October-November
Award recipients and principal nominators are notified of selection.

February-March
Awards are presented during the TMS Annual Meeting

DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE TMS AWARD NOMINATION FORM

Lecture Awards

Institute of Metals Lecture and Robert Franklin Mehl Award, William Hume-Rothery Award, EPD Distinguished Lecturer Award, and TMS/ASM Joint Distinguished Lectureship in Materials and Society Award:

1. Complete nomination form.
2. Current biography or curriculum vitae with publication list.
3. Two-to-five letters of endorsement are optional, but recommended.

Note: lectureship awards are considered two years in advance of the presentation year.

Paper Awards

Champion H. Mathewson Award, EMPMD JEM Award, EPD Science Award, and EPD Technology Award:

1. Complete nomination form.
2. Photocopy or PDF of the nominated paper.
3. Mathewson and EMPMD JEM Awards: nominator's letter of endorsement is required.

Other Awards

Alexander Scott Distinguished Service Award, Application to Practice Award, Brimacombe Medalist, Bruce Chalmers Award, Cyril Stanley Smith Award, Educator Award, Leadership Award, Morris Cohen Award, Robert Lansing Hardy Award, EMPMD Distinguished Scientist/Engineer Award, EMPMD Distinguished Service Award, EPD Distinguished Service Award, EMPMD John Bardeen Award, LMD Distinguished Service Award, LMD Technology Award, MPMD Distinguished Scientist/Engineer Award, MPMD Distinguished Service Award, SMD Distinguished Scientist/Engineer Award, SMD Distinguished Service Award, AIME Honorary Membership, Acta Biomaterialia Gold Medal Award, Acta Materialia Gold Medal Award, and Acta Materialia Materials & Society Award:

1. Complete nomination form.
2. Current biography or curriculum vitae with publication list.
3. A minimum of two, maximum of five, letters of endorsement are required; a minimum of three letters of endorsement are required for Brimacombe Medalist and SMD awards.

TMS Fellow Award and James Douglas Gold Metal

1. Complete nomination form.
2. Current biography or curriculum vitae with publication list.
3. Five letters of endorsement are required.

Note: nominator must be a TMS member for Fellow Award.

Nominator's Supporting Statement

This statement is to be included within the principal nominator's cover letter of endorsement. The supporting statement should outline the qualifications of the nominee for the specific honor/award.

Letters of Endorsement

Letters citing personal knowledge of the nominee's qualifications for the award are required for the Champion H. Mathewson Award, EMPMD JEM award, and all other non-paper awards. Each letter should be no longer than one page. No more than one letter of endorsement may be from the same affiliation as the nominee. The nominator's letter may be counted in the total number required.

Awards Selection Process

Nominations are valid for three years provided they meet criteria for the awards each year, except Early Career Faculty Fellow, Shri Ram Arora Award, and Vittorio de Nora Award which require a separate nomination form each year. For all award recipients, there are no restrictions with respect to nationality, citizenship, TMS membership, race, sex, occupation, and age. Exceptions to age include the Robert Lansing Hardy Award. Exceptions to TMS membership include the AIME Honorary Membership, Alexander Scott Distinguished Service Award, Brimacombe Medalist, Fellow Award, Robert Lansing Hardy Award, EMPMD Distinguished Service Award, EPD Distinguished Service Award, LMD Distinguished Service Award, MPMD Distinguished Scientist/Engineer Award, MPMD Distinguished Service Award, SMD Distinguished Scientist/Engineer Award, and SMD Distinguished Service Award. See criteria for further details. Most awards are presented at the TMS Annual Meeting; specifically, division awards are presented at division functions during the annual meeting.
