The First TMS Summit on Creating and Sustaining Diversity in the Minerals, Metals and Materials Professions (DMMM1) Travel Award for members of the TMS Women in Materials Science & Engineering Committee (WIMSEC)

The Women in Materials Science & Engineering Committee DMMM1 Travel Award provides an opportunity for members of WIMSEC of TMS to advance in the field of materials science through participation in society activities. Through membership on the TMS Women in Science Committee, members participate in the decision-making and long range planning of the society. The program's purpose is two-fold:

- To enhance the professional development of active committee members through leadership opportunities and networking at DMMM1
- To foster an appreciation and desire among members to play an active role in TMS and advance to volunteer leadership positions within the society in coming years

Funding

The Women in Materials Science & Engineering DMMM1 Travel Awards are funded by the TMS Foundation. Five active members of the committee will be chosen to attend DMMM1. Each award recipient receives:

- \$1000 towards travel and housing per award recipient
- Complimentary registration to DMMM1
- Volunteer opportunities at DMMM1, as required by TMS

Award Recipient Responsibilities

- In order to be awarded, recipient must attend the DMMM1 conference. Travel funds are to be used towards airfare and housing only.
- Each award recipient is expected to actively represent the TMS Women in Materials Science & Engineering Committee by volunteering at the DMMM1 conference as directed by conference organizers and TMS.
- Each award recipient must submit a report to WIMSEC on their experience at DMMM1 after the event.

Criteria for Selection

TMS strives to maintain a balance among applicants from industry, government and academia. Applicants must be current TMS members in good standing and active in the Women in Materials Science & Engineering Committee. Criteria to be considered by the division's selection committee are as follows:

- 1. Active participation in Women in Materials Science & Engineering Committee
- 2. History of TMS volunteer activities and willingness to lend support to current and future TMS activities
- 3. Ability to honor professional commitments at the DMMM1conference
- 4. Possession of leadership skills as evidenced through your personal statement
