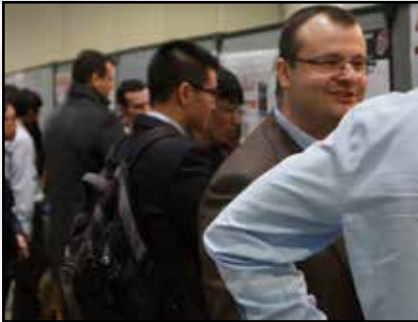

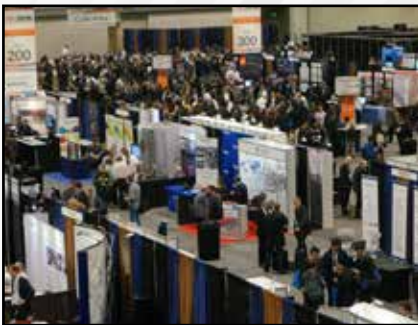


Exhibit at the anchor meeting of the minerals, metals, and materials community: TMS annual meeting programming spans the entire materials life cycle.
