

FRONTIERS IN MATERIALS SCIENCE, ENGINEERING, AND TECHNOLOGY: AN FMD SYMPOSIUM IN HONOR OF SUNGHO JIN

This symposium honors Professor Sungho Jin, winner of the 2016 Acta Materialia Gold Medal Award. It will address frontiers in materials science, engineering, technology, and beyond, including recent advancements in electronic, magnetic, optical, superconducting materials, devices and structures, electronic packaging, microelectromechanical systems (MEMS) materials and devices, nano-bio materials, and energy-related materials.

This special symposium is dedicated to the seminal research contributions of Sungho Jin and to his leadership in materials science worldwide through various professional societies and the University of California, San Diego (UCSD). Jin is professor emeritus at UCSD. Prior to his recent retirement, he was Distinguished Professor of Materials Science in the Departments of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering at UCSD and held the Iwama Endowed Chair. He also served as the director of the university-wide Materials Science & Engineering Program at UCSD for 13 years.
