

JOM Call for papers

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The Composite Materials Committee is seeking papers on the topic of *Metal and Polymer Matrix Composites*

This invited topic is based on a symposium scheduled for Materials Science & Technology 2017. Composite materials have found mainstream application, often to enhance the performance of components and reduce structural weight. A large variety of polymer and metal matrix composites have an overlapping density range with a wide variation in material properties. Topics of interest include all areas of metal and polymer matrix composites including: fiber reinforced composites; natural fiber reinforced composites; solid and hollow particle reinforced composites; nanocomposites; fabrication methods and surface modification of micro and nanoscale reinforcements; processing methods for composite materials; modeling and simulation.

Typical paper length is 5,000 to 6,500 words for review papers, and 2,400 to 4,000 words for original papers.
