**NATURE OF WORK:** The committee meets twice yearly, either in person or electronically. Additional meetings may be called at a chair's discretion. The committee makes decisions on TMS content initiatives and advises the TMS Board of Directors on strategic and business matters.

Committee members sit on one or more subcommittees that focus on:

1. Strategic Planning for Content and Information Capture
2. Engage Volunteer Members in Content Development
3. Oversee TMS Content Media Assets
