



CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS: Award Subcommittee Member

BACKGROUND: In June, this award committee will review nominations and make selections. The committee may propose one candidate each year for each award assigned. The results of committee deliberations shall be kept confidential until the award winners have been approved by the TMS BOD and notified by the TMS Awards Administrator. Awards are presented at the TMS Annual Meeting.

NATURE OF WORK: The committee will recommend to the TMS Honors & Professional Recognition Committee final nominees for the following awards: William Hume-Rothery Award, Champion H. Mathewson Award, Institute of Metals Lecturer/Robert Franklin Mehl Award and Acta Materialia Gold Medal Award. Committee members shall be personally engaged in metallurgical research and have an established reputation as a contributor to his/her field(s) of interest.

DURATION OF WORK: A typical time for commitment is three years as an award subcommittee member. The subcommittee shall meet at each TMS Annual Meeting and at such other times as deemed necessary to conduct its business in a timely and effective manner.
