Considerations for report content include:

- Historical background
- Discussion on safety procedures
- Final blade shown in the report
- Proper acknowledgements, as applicable (funding, university, facility, artisan)

Scientific Merit: 10 points maximum

Considerations for scientific merit include:

- Blade material: source and choice of material clearly stated
- Method of execution explained: forging, pattern-welding, forge welding, etc.
- Explanation of concepts, metallurgy understood (heat treatment, phase transformation, internal stresses, extractive metallurgy if produced from ore, etc.)

Characterization: 10 points maximum

Considerations for characterization include:

- Mechanical properties testing
- Metallography (sample preparation quality, proper magnification, proper etchants)
- Proper use of SEM, EDS (if applicable)
- Other tests (blade geometrical measurements, balance point measurement, etc.)

Communications and Style: 10 points maximum

Considerations for communications and style include:

- Aesthetics and layout
- Correct spelling, fonts, units, formatting
- Report structure: abstract/introduction/experiments/conclusions
- Easy to read and understand (clear sentences, use of proper technical terms)
- Proper referencing
