Primary Aluminum Production Chain: Bauxite-Alumina-Electrode-Reduction

This topic covers all aspects of the primary aluminum production chain, including alumina refining from the Bayer process or fly ash production, electrode manufacturing and technologies, and aluminum reduction electrolysis or alternative processes.

Original research papers should be 3,000-6,000 words with up to 8 figures maximum; review papers should be 6,000-10,000 words with up to 15 figures maximum.
