The Pyrometallurgy Committee is seeking papers on the topic of *Electric Arc Smelting*

The scope of this topic encompasses the primary smelting of materials in electrode furnaces, including Cu, Ni, Pt, Si, and ferroalloys, encompassing industrial trends, emerging technology and furnace design; electrode technology; refractory and freeze linings, furnace process control, tapping, safety, and environmental control.

Original research papers should be 3,000-6,000 words with up to 8 figures maximum; review papers should be 6,000-10,000 words with up to 15 figures maximum.
